# **House Spotlight**

This month we feature Barry Mah Ming, our personable, outgoing President.





Born and raised in Red Deer Alberta, Barry is the youngest of four children. After graduating from secondary school, he attended the University of Alberta to receive his Bachelor of Arts in Economics with a minor in Political Science. Law school followed, and Barry moved to Toronto to attend Osgoode Hall at York University. Subsequently, he articled with the Federal Department of Justice in Vancouver, primarily as a drug Prosecutor. In 1975, he joined the BC Provincial government as a prosecutor before entering private practice, and then retired in 1998. For a short time in his retirement, Barry was a Tour Director taking clients through the Rockies and other parts of British Columbia.

Looking to find his roots, Barry visited China (his grandfather came to Victoria in 1902 and his mother was born here), and ended up staying there for 10 years teaching English. There he experienced the SARS health crisis, the Sichuan earthquake, the Beijing Olympics and Expo in Shanghai.

Barry does a lot of volunteer work outside of Goward House, including: the Cat Rescue Corps, the Lions Club, the Victoria Art Gallery, the Royal BC Museum, and the Canada-China Friendship Association. In addition, he does Board work with Big Brothers & Sisters, the John Howard Society and the YM-YWCA. He also enjoys politics and sports - Barry is a "sports nut" who participates in curling and lawn bowling and walks his 10,000 plus steps a day! A dedicated pet owner, Barry has 5 cats and a dog named Bridget.

Barry joined Goward House in 2012 when he returned to Canada for good, and is very happy to be a volunteer for the Society. He is our newly retired President, and remains a very valued member on the Board.
